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## KENJAYEVA MUNIRA'S PROPAGANDA ACTIVITY CONCERNING WITH OGAHI

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**Abstract:** This article is about Munira Kenjayeva's advocacy work on the life and career of Ogahi, a multitalented artist.

The people of ancient Khorezm are the land of great scientists and poets who contributed to world civilization. Such a legacy serves as the foundation for today's new Renaissance. When talking about the great poets and scientists of Khorezm, one of the ancient centers of science, art and literature, the blessed name of the multi-talented Muhammad Rizo Erniyozbek oglu Ogahi, of course, was mentioned, poetry, translation, his work in the field of historiography is proudly recognized.

One of the great people who left an indelible mark on the history of the Khiva khanate in the XIX century was Muhammad Riza Erniyozbek oglu Ogahi. Born in 1809 in the village of Qiyot, near Khiva, to a mirab family, the writer wrote, "We are the descendants of Amir Eshimbi, one of the hundred tribes living in Khiva." Agahi created a school of translation studies by translating more than 20 works of world literature and culture into Uzbek.

In addition, the establishment of the Agahi School of Creativity is a manifestation of the President's noble goal of immortalizing the spirit of famous writers. We, the new Uzbeks, are the descendants of the unique and unique traditions of our ancestors. A few innovations in education and initiatives like these are projects that are designed for the distant future, not today or tomorrow.

In particular, I started my career at the Agahi School of Creativity. As you enter the Agahi School of Creativity, you will be surrounded by a unique literary environment. Today, Ogahi's hot poetry is echoed by young people. As a translator and historian, the talented poet, who is deeply respected by Navoi, has written about 30 masterpieces. He has written in more than 19 genres of classical poetry. His work "Taviz ul-ashiqin" is especially famous. The sources of thought contained in Agahi's purmano ghazals and muhammas are distinguished by their high spiritual significance and artistic level.

At the same time, the Ogahi House Museum in Khiva has been enriched with new content today. The building has been renovated and turned into a beautiful place. Despite the fact that a century and a half has passed, the roots of the original literature and sharia are so strong that today they sound with a new breath, a new tone. It is like a mulberry tree that Ogahi once planted with his own hands and each sprout sprouted new branches. While touring the Agahi Creativity School and Home Museum, I took a video of memorabilia to share with other friends. This video is about Agahi's life and career and the changes that are taking place today, and it will arouse the interest of others.



It should be noted that our TSUOS is tasked to study and promote the creative work of Hazrat Ogahi, the successor of Alisher Navoi, a representative of the classical literature of the East, and extensive work is being done at our university in this regard. In particular, on the occasion of the 211st anniversary of the birth of Muhamman Rizo Erniyazbi oglu Ogahi, a series of roundtables and events on "Ogahi's enlightenment in the interpretation of young orientalists" are being organized.

I have personally organized the circle under the leadership of my scientific adviser Saydazimova Umida Turakhanovna. In order to please the souls of Hazrat Ogahi, various poetry evenings and educational events have been held around the Ogahi statue in the Alley of Writers.

As part of the 2020-2021 academic year, the university stage of the republican contest "Square of Enlightenment" under the motto "New Uzbekistan - a new worldview" among students of higher educational institutions will be held on May 19 at TSUOS. Teams of 8 participants from all faculties competed on the basis of 3 conditions related to the life and work of our great-grandfather Ogahi. In the uncompromising competition, our team of students from the Faculty of Korean Studies won the competition with 63 points and took 1st place. During the competition, our team demonstrated their knowledge of the life and work of Ogahi and the writers whose statues were erected in the Alley of Writers, and presented interesting compositions based on various scenes and poems by Ogahi. This year we also took part in the Republican stage and won a place of honor.
