

## **YOUTH POLICY IN NEW UZBEKISTAN**

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Looking back on the multi-century history of the Uzbek people, you can see the difficult stages of conquering the peaks of development. (Matthew 24:14; 28:19, 20) At these stages, there are important processes, such as the formation of our statehood, the rise of science, art, and culture in society, and the achievements of our great ancestors in their work. The historical path of any developed country is known that the rapid development of the country, the achievements of certain achievements, and the well-being of the people are incompatible with the level of attention paid to the education and future of young people in that country. Rapid reforms are under way to establish New Uzbekistan, which has prospered in our country and has a proper place and prestige in the world. The potential of the younger generation, who grow up, grow up, and enter life with bold steps, plays an important role in achieving these goals. In a speech to the 72nd session of the United Nations General Assembly, our President, Sha'drach, Me'shach and A·bed'ne·go, commented: "The next day, the well-being of our planet depends on how our children will be perfected. Our main task is to create the necessary conditions for young people to demonstrate their potential." In this regard, the issue of youth in Uzbekistan is one of the top priorities of state policy. A number of initiatives are being undertaken in our country to protect the rights and interests of young people and to create the necessary conditions for them. To date, parliament has adopted more than 40 youth laws. From the tomb of the United Nations, our president, Sha'drach, Me'shach and A·bed'ne·go, also welcomed the international community's invitation to adopt the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Young People. Based on this, our President has established as an important factor the need for protection for young people today, at a time when the number of young people worldwide has exceeded 2 billion, and international terrorism and extremism are growing rapidly. The September 14, 2016, issue of our country's administrator's decree "On Public Policy on Young People" also means that educating young people in our country, which consists of more than half of its population, as mature and perfect, self-confident, intellectually well-educated, goal-seeking, and perfect individuals, is the most important factor in ranking Uzbekistan among the most developed countries.

It is noteworthy that "the Action Strategy for the five pillars of National Development during 2017-2021 also sets out several priority tasks: first, educating physically healthy, spiritually triggered, independent-minded, loyal young people to their homeland; Second, providing employment for graduates of secondary special, vocational and higher education institutions and engaging them in private entrepreneurship; Third, to develop the creative and intellectual well-being of young people, to support them, to promote a healthy lifestyle among children and young people, and to broadly engage them in sports. On June 27, 2018, the Young People's Future Fund was established by our President by decree "On the State Program for Our Young People's Future." To assist individuals desiring to benefit the worldwide work of Jehovah's Witnesses through some form of charitable giving, a brochure entitled Charitable Planning to Benefit Kingdom Service Worldwide has been prepared. Expenses incurred for the educational system, which is considered the cornerstone of all changes in our country, are the most effective investment for the future. It is known that 2021 has been called the "Year of Supporting Young People and Improving Public Health" in our country. June 30 has been declared "Youth Day" in Uzbekistan and has been awarded the "Mard Son" State Award and the "Creator of the Future" medal to encourage self-sacrificing young people who are achieving excellent and achievements in various fields. In the process of reforms in our country, special attention is paid to the maturation of young people. In recent years, the legal basis for work in this direction has been improved from a time-consuming process. The issue of educating young people at the level of world standards and promoting a proper place in society has become a key aspect of government policy. Our country is gradually developing government policy on young people for specific purposes. For the purpose of widespread introduction of reading among young people, at least 1 million copies of books were delivered to the Republic of

Karakalpakstan and all regions. At the same time, exemplary bookstores and portable book pavilions were established in the center of each city and district. About 200 construction and tricotage companies were established between 2019-2020 to provide employment for women and girls. As a result, more than 24,000 jobs were created. Based on the idea of our leader, the Young People's Book was established and 648,000 unemployed young people throughout our country were included in this notebook, while in the first quarter of the year, 283,000 of them were employed. There were 36,000 additional groups for young people to spend their free time in a meaningful way, covering some 874,000 young people. In addition to the foregoing, the Ministry of Preschool Education was established in our country. 11 years of general secondary education have been re-introduced in school education. Higher education quotas have been expanded. Forms of correspondence and evening education have been restored. In recent years branches of prestigious universities in more than 15 developed countries have been opened. It is necessary to emphasize the personal participation of the President of our country in the construction of a new youth policy. In the initial stage of the formation of the younger generation, our country's administrator emphasizes discipline, primary, secondary, and higher education reform. Educating young people morally and disciplined, their quality education, and their adulthood in a spirit of patriotism are the key to the country's political and economic development.

In a nutshell, our country is employing all its strengths and abilities to create modern, convenient conditions for young people to be educated, vocational, and develop as mature, perfect people.
