Subsequently, the term CALL is not was used due to its association with a method oriented towards the teacher, and not the student, and the concept of TELL came to replace it - Technology Enhanced Language Learning.

Later, this principle found its new embodiment in pocket personal computers (PDAs) or smartphones, and since the 1990s the concept of mobile assistance appeared in the study of foreign languages - MALL.
