What kind of society is this? The answer seems familiar to everyone: it's civil society. The main path of development of Uzbekistan is the democratization of society and the building of a civil state. Building a democratic society in Uzbekistan, first of all, is to acquaint the population with the millennial history, spiritual development, great culture, spiritual heritage and rich traditions of the Uzbek people, to gain sufficient knowledge about them. It is necessary to create conditions for One of such conditions is to acquaint students with the national history, culture and way of life in the educational process, to inculcate national values in the content of educational sciences and spiritual and educational activities. Acquaintance with the socio-philosophical, historical, pedagogical and psychological literature on the problem, comprehensive study of students' activities, direct communication with students, pedagogical analysis of their activities revealed some problems in the formation of a culture of civic literacy, showed. Including:

- The formation of a culture of civic literacy among students does not play a leading role in the activities of the university (both in the educational process and in the organization of spiritual and educational activities);
- Most students do not have enough understanding of what spiritual and moral qualities are based on the concepts of "citizen" and "citizenship";
- Insufficient scientific and methodological recommendations for the effective formation of civic literacy;
- Introduce students to the ethical approach to civic literacy in the plan of spiritual and educational activities, the basics, components of this status, the factors of development of civic literacy, as well as the interaction on the development of civic literacy related activities were not reflected;
- There is no integrated system for the development of civic literacy among students and no well-founded mechanism.
